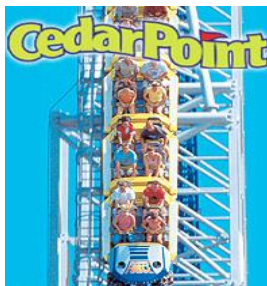

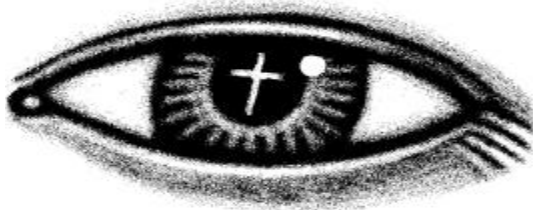
Leadership Institute Tuesday, August 2, 2005 at Maumee Bay State Park Lodge
