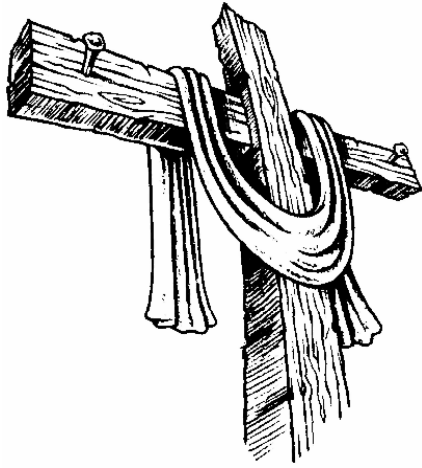


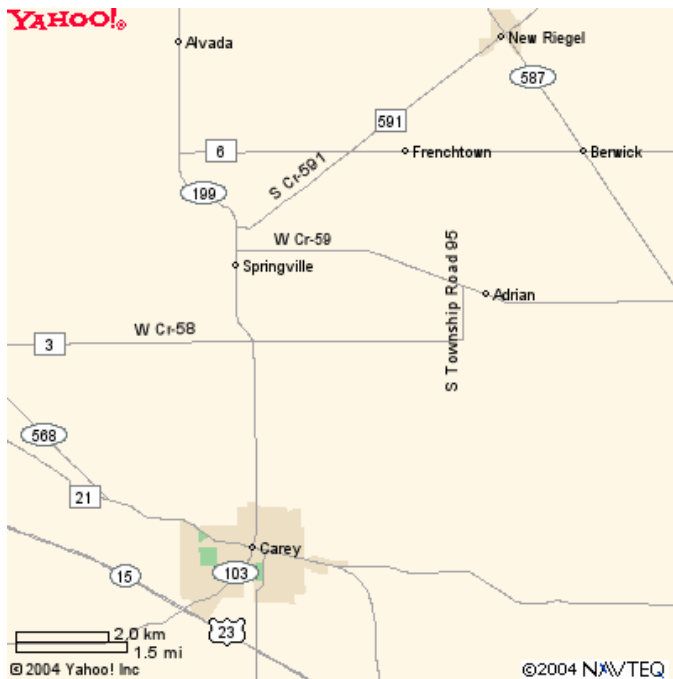
WALK FOR LIFE
