

Brighton Advisory Committee (BAC)

The Pastoral Planning Process for our diocese was begun in the mid-90's, with various regions on their own timelines. In 2004, the Brighton Oversight Committee(BOC) completed its work of planning how the churches of the Brighton Region would cluster when the time came. Since 2004, much preparatory work has been done between the parishes slated to cluster:

- 1) *St. Thomas More & Our Lady Queen of Peace and***
- 2) *St. Anne & Our Lady of Lourdes.***

The Brighton Oversight Committee (BOC) has been succeeded by the Brighton Advisory Committee. The work of this group is to support the process as it moves on to the clustering, which may well happen in 2008.
