"The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few: so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest" (Luke 10:2). Jesus sent out 72 disciples to spread the Good News. They were to announce the Kingdom of God, to bring peace to the household, to welcome the people, to cure the sick and to proclaim the Gospel message. The task was not an easy one. If these disciples were not accepted, they were to move on to the next village.

As "disciples in mission", we, too, can be misunderstood, not accepted, ignored and sometimes be put down. We are called to be people of hope. St. Paul's message of bearing the marks of Jesus for the sake of the kingdom is a call to trust that our mission will not go in vain. The kingdom of God will endure.
