#142 (about Scrutinies) *The Elect must have the intention of achieving an intimate knowledge of Christ and his church, and are expected particularly to progress in genuine self-knowledge through serious examination of their lives and true repentance* — Let's give good example by doing the same through Reconciliation.

Presentation of the Lord's Prayer - We lovingly entrust the Our Father to the Elect at the Tuesday evening Mass. They received the *Creed* two weeks ago. The *Lord's Prayer* will en-lighten the Elect with a deeper sense of adoption by which they can call God their Father, especially in the midst of the Eucharistic assembly.
