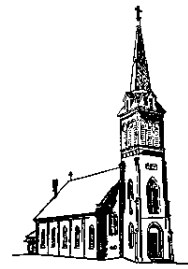

Young Children at Mass

The number of young children at Mass is a wonderful sign that our parish is alive and well.

Parents of toddlers are encouraged to bring their children to Mass to teach them how to participate and to expose them to proper behavior. The rest of us need to be patient so to give the children a chance to learn this.

On the other hand, a screaming child who is not at all receptive to learning anything should be taken outside, at least behind the glass doors in the bell tower. A good rule of thumb to me seems to be “if you would take them away from the family’s Thanksgiving dinner,” then please do take the child out of the church building until they calm down.
