St. John Fiscal Year Ends

Our 2004-2005 financial year has just closed. Thanks to all our families who supported our parish needs through their weekly or monthly offering gifts. Without your overwhelming generosity, our parish would not exist.

Our parish finance council estimates our 2005-2006 needs will increase 4.8% over the previous year's expenditures. We are asking parishioners to consider increasing

their offerings to match this need. As examples, a weekly gift of \$10.00 increased to \$10.48, or \$20.00 to \$20.96 will help us continue to provide the same level of support to our parish families.

And even of more importance, we need to increase our prayers for our parish community. As we face the challenges the shortage of priests brings to our parish and our neighboring parishes, we must pray for more involvement of the time

and talents of our parish members so that we may continue to meet all our needs. Again, we thank you for your gifts to our church, and assure you that your finance council continues to work diligently to keep tight reign on our expenditures, while providing the services that our parish needs.
