Opening School Liturgy and Mother Teresa Harvest

The St. Joseph Regional School Opening Liturgy, which is being prepared by our sixth graders, will be celebrated next Friday, September 14, 2007 at 9:30 AM. We hope that you will be able to join us.

On this occasion we will have our annual Mother Teresa Harvest Offertory for the poor. Every member of the SJRCS Community (teachers, students, staff, and parents) is asked to bring fresh produce with him or her. Fresh vegetables, fruits and breads would be most appropriate. (Note: melons of all types and fresh corn on the cob are usually in short supply.) Items from your own garden that you have harvested would be great and would recall the original student idea that began this drive eight years ago. However, a "supermarket harvest" is just as wonderful. Please do not bring any frozen, canned or boxed items or anything needing refrigeration. Fresh produce only, please.

All donated produce will be placed in the sanctuary and presented at the opening of our liturgy. (In the early church, people would bring farm animals to be presented to the priest!) After our liturgy, the offertory harvest will be brought to Lazarus House and area soup kitchens.
