Founded in 1990, Action of Churches Together in Scotland (ACTS) is Scotland's "national ecumenical instrument" a joint initiative of the Church of Scotland, Congregational Federation, Methodist Church, Religious Society of Friends, Roman Catholic Church, Salvation Army, Scottish Episcopal Church, United Free Church of Scotland and United Reformed Church.
