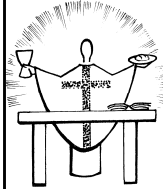




### SATURDAY EVENING VIGIL MASS

### The origins of our name:

Mary's Meals is named after Mary, the mother of Jesus, who brought up her own child in poverty. Mary's Meals grew out of the Christian Catholic faith of our founders and the values and ethos we hold reflect this.

We consist of, respect, and reach out to people of all faiths and none.

The roots of Scottish International Relief, which later became known as Mary's Meals, are to be found in Medjugorje, a small village in Bosnia-Herzegovina, where it is claimed the Virgin Mary has been appearing since 1981. Those responsible for the founding of our work became involved as a result of their experiences at Medjugorje.

The name itself, 'Mary's Meals' was inspired by a desire to dedicate this work to Mary, the Mother of Jesus.

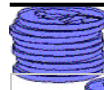
