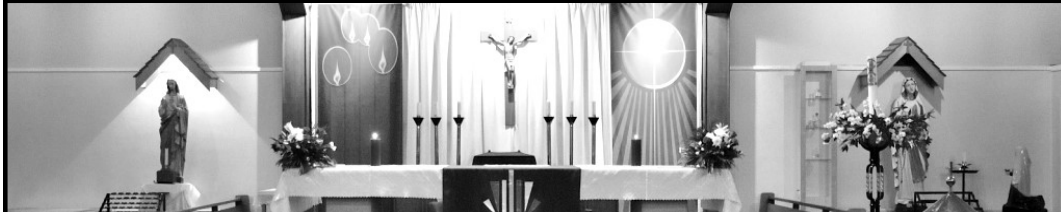

BRAZIL COINS AND CLOTHES.....

Please take a jar from the back of the church to collect spare coins for Brazil. This money helps small projects that get very little and often no other support. We also send 2 cases of clothes to Brazil in September and December. People have been very good in the past, instead of throwing out children's clothes they handed them in to send to Brazil.

Newly born baby clothes

For the end of May, June and July we are looking for new born baby clothes (3months to a year) to be sent to Brazil in July. There are 4 known cases of young mothers about to give birth who really could do with some help. If you have any second hand baby clothes – try and avoid "woollies" are they are not very helpfull in a tropical climate – please hand into the sacristy or Fr. Mike soon.
