

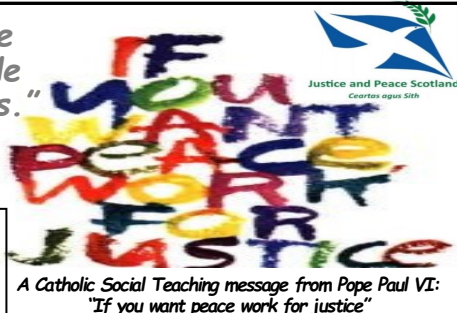
We are still looking for pass-keepers for both vigil and Sunday masses. If you can help please speak to Fr. Mike.
