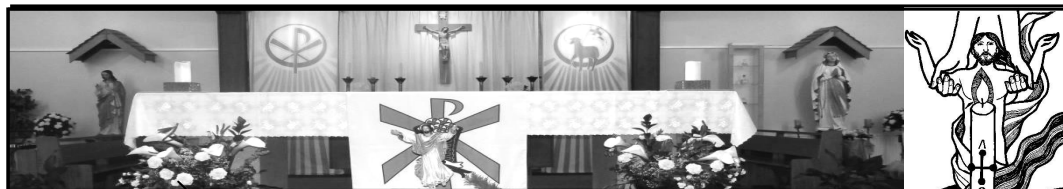

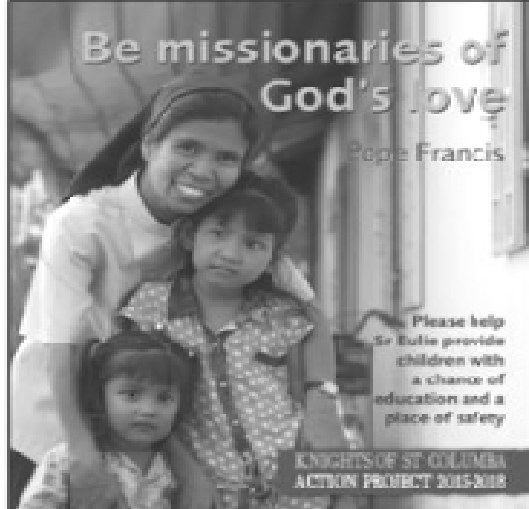
MISSIO + Missio Scotland
