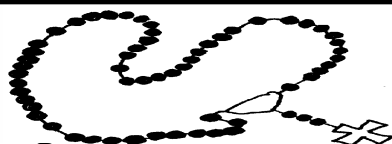

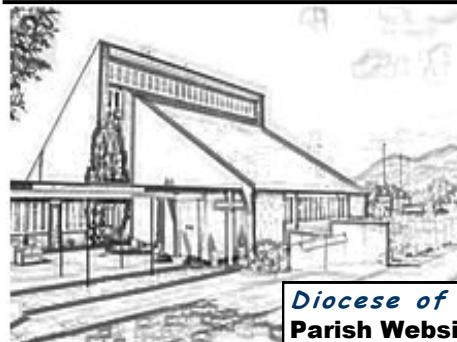
Knights of St. Columba Rosary Crusade for Peace:
