**THE LORD IS MY SHEPHERD**

During the span of our careers, we usually have a boss. There's always someone a little bit higher than we are who is responsible for overseeing what we do. Occasionally, we may reach that highest rung of the ladder -- whether it's as the owner, CEO or President -- and we're responsible for everything that happens in that particular organization. That's how I feel about this appointment. In secular vernacular, I'm the boss. In God's eyes, I'm the shepherd of His flock.

Now, the only trouble with being the boss is that you have no one to blame if stuff goes wrong. Harry Truman said it: "The buck stops here." Any huge mistakes I make could "cause the sheep to scatter." Our reading in *Jeremiah 23* says, "**Woe to the shepherds who are destroying and scattering the sheep of my pasture!**" declares the Lord. That's the warning, but here's what will happen if the shepherd is not careful: "**Because you have scattered my flock and driven them away and have not bestowed care on them, I will bestow punishment on you for the evil you have done.**"

It makes me realize there would be nothing worse than having God upset with me. I take that seriously. But, how can I keep from making mistakes? Psalm 23:1 is the answer: making the Lord my Shepherd. I do that by keeping myself close to Him by reading and studying His word and by praying for His help and His guidance. In doing this, I'm making Him my boss and trusting Him to give me the necessary gifts I need to care for His flock.

Let me challenge all of you who are in positions of authority, from Mom and Dad to the president of a company or the country, to stop trying to do it alone. Make the Lord your Shepherd and see if you don't experience the same peace and assurance that David writes about in Psalm 23 -- even in the Valley of the Shadow of Death.

If you've never met my boss, The Good Shepherd, stop in to see me and I'll introduce you. I guarantee He'll change your life.

***The person who builds his life on the Bible is like the builder who constructs his house on solid rock. The storms of life will not destroy what he builds. Read your Bible and give it a visible place in your home that will encourage you to read and study it.***

Here is a list of the changes that are being made and the reason for doing so.

- I have instituted a Welcoming Announcement at the beginning of Mass. It is important that we become a welcoming parish to the community.
- Weekday Mass at SF for Wednesdays was changed from 7:30 am to 9:00 am to accommodate the priests' work schedule.
- Front page of the bulletin has been revised and will contain a scripture-based article as well as other information about what is happening in the parish.
