## **WE ARE NUMBER ONE** **17<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time**

*"...so that they may be one as We are one..." Jn. 17:11*

I'm not a big sports fan, but I've been to enough ball games to know that fans are a cohesive group of people. If you like the Bills, you're part of a large group of supporters. Now, with that said, not everybody is a Bills' fan, maybe you're a Giants or a Jets' fan, but we are still football fans. When fans get together, they often have, "friendly rivalry". Maybe there's some good-natured betting going on. During a game, each might cheer for a different team, but they're all enjoying the same ballgame.

What sports lovers realize is that without **two** teams cooperating, there won't be **one** game. That doesn't mean that every Bills' fan agrees with everything the team does, nor would they always agree on who was the "most valuable player" in a particular game. All in all, for fans, winning is wonderful, but it's the playing of the game that entertains them. It's getting together with like-minded people and cheering the players and being awed by a play that stimulates them.

I don't think there would be many fans if the teams consisted of two guys in Dockers and Polo shirts who go to the middle of the field, toss a coin to see who wins and then both of them go home — game over. This makes me realize that adversity has some charms.

This same spirit of unity and cooperation we see in a football game is what St. Paul is calling for when he tells the Ephesians (4:2:6), ***"bearing with one another through love, striving to preserve the unity of the spirit through the bond of peace: one body and one Spirit, as you were also called to the one hope of your call, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all."***

St. Paul is saying that even though you are Jew or Greek, male or female, slave or free, a member of St. Hyacinth's or St. Francis', you're all called to one faith in Jesus Christ. Who you are shouldn't matter. What matters is the game. And there's no game without unity between the teams.

Perhaps you can look at our two churches as one would look at the NFL and the name of the game is **Love**. There are lots of individual teams. No one is asking St. Francis to become St. Hyacinth or St. Hyacinth to become St. Francis. Instead, we want these two teams to play the same game, with the goal of loving and serving the people of this community in the name of Jesus Christ.

So dust off your helmet of **salvation** and shoulder pads of **righteousness**, put on those cleats of **peace** and kneepads of **faith**. Cover yourself with your jersey of the Holy Spirit, and let's be **number 1** in **love, unity** and **Jesus Christ**.

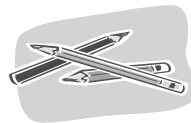
