

REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY.

Today we remember all of the dead from all wars and conflicts.

This day was set apart originally to remember the dead of the First World War that ended on the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month in 1918.

On this day normally at 11am there is silence and throughout the day in churches, cemeteries, war memorials and public crosses wreaths are laid. At St. Bernadette's a wreath has been placed at the outside cross and in both parishes as Sunday mass begins a wreath will be placed at the altar. In the past Remembrance Day was called Armistice Day and in the USA it is known as Veterans Day.

Lasallian Developing World Projects have operated successfully in a dozen different countries. Aiming to involve people in the schools of Britain in tackling some of the educational problems faced by people of poorer countries. Teams of young people from all over GB take part in overseas projects we sponsor. Since 1985, we have sent over 500 (mostly young) people. Many spent their summer holiday working on a building site, taking instructions from local craftsmen. In that time they have built: 48 classrooms; 2 teachers offices; 38 dwellings for teachers and families; 2 churches and 1 multiple-services assembly hall; 5 hostels for pupils living too far from school to walk; 2 rain tanks, to save pupils' school time spent fetching water. **MORE INFO AT** <http://www.delasalle.org.uk/>
