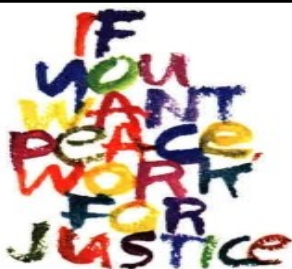

Congratulations to all the young people who are celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation this weekend.

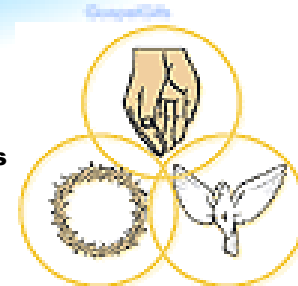
We hope this is an important day for you all on your journey of faith.
