Things to Bring Checklist

Important Item:

- Sleeping Bag (bring blanket if the sleeping is thin)
- Pillow
- Bible (Old & New Testament)
- Rosary
- Care Card
- Necessary Medicine
- Floor Sheet/Mat/Cushion (for **Eucharistic Adoration**)

Clothing:

- T-Shirt/ Sweatshirt
- Change of Pants/ Shorts/Underwear & Socks
- **Long sleeves Jacket** / Raingear/Cap
- Indoor Slipper/ Sandal
- **Hiking Shoe or Sport Shoe**

Toiletries:

- Face Cloth/ Towel
- Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- Soap or Shower Gel/ Shampoo & Conditioner
- Sun block & Lotion
- Shower Cap/ Hairdryer

Other Things to Bring:

- Mug or Water Bottle
- Notebook/ Pen or Pencil
- Insect Repellent
- Snacks
- Hangers
- Torch or Flashlight
- Petty Cash (not more than\$50.00)
- Outdoor mat
- **Positive Attitude & an Open Heart**

Do Not Bring:

- MP3 players, Radio, Discman & any other Electronic Entertainment device(s)
- Play Cards, Chess/Board Game, Ball & any other Sport Equipment(S)
- **Negativity**

NB: It is preferred that all item be packed in a Large travel Bag. Each Camper is limited to a maximum of 1 piece of luggage and 1 sleeping Bag. Please be sure that your bag(s) is well identified.

WCCCLC 2009 Housekeeping Rules

- (1) All participants must be registered. Only registered members are allowed in the premises and entitled to the privileges of the living camp.
- (2) Participants must attend all meetings and group activities at the specified time, any absences must be reported to the group facilitators.
- (3) Please keep the premises clean and tidy. Participants may be charged for damages. Report any facility failures to house parents, overall coordinators, or your group facilitators.
- (4) Smoking is not allowed in the indoor facilities.
- (5) Alcohol is not allowed throughout the camp.
- (6) Please take off your shoes when entering the main Lodge.
- (7) No cellular phone or pager is allowed during the activities.
- (8) Participants are encouraged to go to bed before 12 midnight in order to have enough energy to enjoy the program following day.
- (9) Participants must sleep in their assigned cabins. If special arrangement is needed, please contact a House Father or a House Mother. All bedrooms (except your own) are considered private areas. Do not enter unless you are given permission to do so.
- (10) All types of water sports are prohibited.
- (11) No pets are allowed.
- (12) Moving or removing of furniture or equipment from any building is prohibited unless permission is granted by the management.
- (13) Although there is no noise curfew, please be considerate and keep noise to a minimum after 12 midnight.
- (14) Please contact a House Father, a House Mother or your group facilitator if you have any problems or concerns.
- (15) If you feel concerned about your personal safety, privacy, or security in the camp, please report to the overall coordinators. Information given will be kept strictly confidential.
