PARISH NURSE'S CORNER

St. Mary's Parish Nurse program began in 2005 when 5 nurses attended the training program sponsored by Carle. Today, the program has 4 nurses. To be a parish nurse you must be an RN with a current license. Continuing ed hours are required by the licensing board of the state to renew the license every 2 years. St. Mary's nurses are volunteers, not paid. Some churches have salaried nurses. The nurses provide services that include setting up medications, education on meds, procedures, medical problems, referrals to other services, assisting with simple procedures, listening and spirituality. Blood pressures are taken once a month or when requested. Our nurses sponsor blood drives every year, educate on the Vials of Life, and help needy people with food thru the food pantry.
