Illinois Law on Advanced Directives, Living Will and DNR orders: You have the right to make decisions about health care you get now and in the future. An advance directive is a written statement you prepare about how you want your medical decisions to be made in the future if you are no longer able to make them for yourself. A do not resuscitate order (DNR order) is a medical treatment order that says cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) will not be used if your heart and/breathing stops. A living will tells your health care professional whether you want death-delaying procedures used if you have a terminal condition and are unable to state your wishes. A living will, unlike a health care power of attorney, only applies if you have a terminal condition.

Mental Health Treatment Preference Declaration: This lets you say if you want to receive electroconvulsive treatment (ECT) or psychotropic medicine when you have a mental illness and are unable to make these decisions for yourself. It also allows you to say whether you wish to be admitted to a mental health facility for up to 17 days of treatment.
