#### Blood Facts: GIVE BLOOD, SAVE LIVES

- An adult has approximately 10-12 pints of blood
- About 1 in 7 patients require a blood transfusion
- More than 4 million people need blood transfusions each year
- All donated blood is tested for various viruses and diseases before being transfused including: Hepatitis B & C, HIV, HCV, HTLV, Syphilis, West Nile virus and Chagas disease.
- A person with AB+ blood is a universal recipient, and a person with O- blood is a universal donor
- 36K units of blood is needed every day
- 1 pint saves 3 or more lives
- Blood or whole blood is made up of four components: 1% White blood cells, 55% plasma, 44% Red blood cells and Platelets that help the clotting process
- 38% of the US population is eligible to give blood but less than 10% donate

**Please review the information** on Donor Eligibility included in the weeks' bulletin as there are many misconceptions on donating blood. *When donating, please eat a good meal, drink fluids and bring identification.*

#### Volunteer Opportunities for All Ages

**Host Homes:** One home for two females and one home for two males are needed in Danville from Saturday evening, June 15, through Friday morning, June 21 for the *Totus Tuus* team. Each host is asked to provide sleeping quarters, laundry facilities and a continental breakfast.

**Food:** Host the team of four for dinner one evening or provide lunch items to feed the team for one meal.

**Students entering grades 1-12,** the day session for grades 7-12 is June 17-20 from 7-9pm and for grades 1-6 June 16-21, 9am-2:30pm, both at Schlarman Academy South. **Fee** for grades 1-6 is \$25 and \$15 for grades 7-12 with a \$50 maximum per family.
