October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month. Cancer is a disease in which cells in the body grow out of control. Except for skin cancer, breast cancer is the most common cancer in American women.

Breast cancer screening means checking a woman's breasts for cancer before she has any symptoms. A mammogram is an x-ray picture of the breast. Mammograms are the best way to find breast cancer early, when it is easier to treat and before it is big enough to feel or cause symptoms.

Most women who are 50 to 74 years old should have a screening mammogram every two years. If you are 40 to 49 years old, or think you may have a higher risk of breast cancer, ask your doctor when to have a screening mammogram.

Risk factors that influence you breast cancer risk are a family history of breast cancer, taking hormones in menopause for more than five years, never giving birth, starting menopause after age 55, getting radiation therapy to the breast or chest, being overweight, especially after menopause.

Some warning signs of breast cancer are a lump in the breast or underarm, thickening or swelling of part of the breast, any changes in the size or the shape of the breast, irritation or dimpling of breast skin, pain in the breast. Other conditions can cause these symptoms but call the doctor if you are concerned.

HTOTW: The Illinois Breast and Cervical Cancer Program (IBCCP), provided through Champaign Urbana Public Health Department, will hold enrollment days throughout the month of October supporting Breast Cancer Awareness Month. IBCCP assists women who are without insurance between the ages of 35 -64. CUPHD serves the Champaign, McLean and Vermilion County areas. When enrolling in the program, participants will be required to bring proof of age and income to complete the process.
