

PARISH OUTREACH PROGRAMS

St. Bede Parish has several programs that minister to parishioners when needed:

MARTHA'S MINISTRY

is a program that helps parishioners by providing meals during a time of illness, a crisis or welcoming a new baby. Generous parishioner cooks prepare a meal and deliver it. The recipient not only receives a delicious meal but also a visit from someone who cares.

MIRYAM'S HOUSE

is a shelter for homeless women in Pittsburgh. Once a month, parishioner cooks and bakers provide a meal for the residents.

The co-coordinator of the St. Bede program calls people and asks for a food item – meat, vegetable, salad, dessert, which is brought to the rectory on the 2nd Monday of every month.

Volunteers pick it up and take it to Miryam's House on Fifth Avenue.

The women who receive it are most grateful for the delicious dinners that come from St. Bede Parish.
