(50% of the money offered for the mass intention will be used in a small Brazilian project.)



Origins of All Saints' Day

The roots of All Saints' Day trace back to the early Christian Church. Initially, the faithful honoured martyrs who gave their lives for their beliefs. These commemorations often took place on specific dates associated with their martyrdom. However, as Christianity grew, the number of martyrs increased, making it challenging to assign a distinct day to each.

By the 4th century, the practice began to shift. A shared day for honouring all martyrs was established, first being observed in the Eastern Church around May. Later, in the 7th century, Pope Boniface IV formalised the celebration in the Western Church. He dedicated the Pantheon in Rome to "Mary and all martyrs" on May 13th, marking the origins of All Saints' Day as a unified observance.

The date was moved to November 1st in the 8th century under Pope Gregory III, coinciding with the dedication of an oratory in St. Peter's Basilica to all saints. This shift connected the festival with the autumnal season and also aligned it with earlier pagan traditions.



Hosted by the Bishops' Conference of Scotland's Care of Creation Office and supported by Justice & Peace Scotland, SCIAF, and SCES this Mass will be celebrated by Archbishop Nolan in St. Andrew's Cathedral, Glasgow, to pray for the success of the COP30 climate summit in Brazil. After Mass, join us for refreshments at 2pm in Eyre Hall and a live video update from SCIAF's Ben Wilson, reporting from COP30.

We have been told that the Presiding Officer of the Scottish Parliament, Alison Johnstone, will be in attendance, which is an indication of the parliament's support for such an occasion, and we would be delighted if you too were able to join us to pray for the success of COP30.




