**Preparing for Spring Weather:** Spring is here with all its changes including the weather. Locally, we must be prepared for severe windstorms, lightning and tornadoes. Here are a few tips to keep you safer this spring:

- Keep a battery-operated flashlight, battery operated radio and extra batteries
- Have an emergency evacuation or shelter plan
- Keep a list of important personal information and update it regularly
- Have an easily accessible first aid kit and update items as needed for each family member
- Keep a 3-5 day supply of bottled water and nonperishable food
- Have blankets/sleeping bags available
- Make sure all family members are aware of the safest location in the home away from windows
- Make sure you have a plan for your pets
- Make a family communications plan and keep it updated
