**Totus Tuus**, a Latin phrase meaning “totally yours” was the motto of the late Pope John Paul II. This is a diocesan sponsored, summer youth program for grades 1-12 which demonstrates that one can be a faithful Catholic and still have fun. ### **NURSE'S CORNER**

Soon we will be having warm weather again, which will mean outdoor activities, sports and traveling. Usually during the winter we don’t use our first aid kit that we have in the car as much as in the summer. So, we should check it and any other for replacement items and get rid of all outdated supplies. Some items you might want in your kit:

- Acetaminophen, ibuprofen and low dose aspirin
- Antihistamine
- Anti-nausea/motion sickness medication
- Bandages such as 2x2 & 4x4 size
- Band-aids
- Gauze wrap
- Non-allergenic tape
- Triangle bandage
- Elastic wraps
- Disposable cloths
- Sharp scissors with rounded tips
- Antiseptic cleansing solution, wipes, alcohol pads
- Antibiotic ointment
- Disposable instant-activating cold packs
- A first-aid manual

Always check for any allergies before giving first aid
