## **NURSE'S CORNER:**

**SELF CPR REVIEW:** What are you to do if you have a heart attack while you are alone? The Johnson City Medical Center staff discovered this, did an in-depth study and determined it does work. It is called Cough CPR. If experiencing heart attack symptoms, always call 9-1-1 immediately. Since many people are alone when they suffer a heart attack this self procedure has proven life saving. The person can help themselves by coughing repeatedly and very vigorously. A deep breath should be taken before each cough and the cough must be deep and prolonged, as when producing sputum. From deep inside the chest a breath and a cough must be repeated about every 2 seconds without let up until help arrives or until the heart is felt to be beating normally again. Deep breathes get oxygen into the lungs and coughing movements squeeze the heart and keeps blood circulating. squeezing pressure on the heart also helps it regain normal rhythm.
