Immunizations for Adults >19 years

This week we conclude with the CDC recommended immunization for adults, 19 years and older:

<u>Influenza</u> – 1 dose annually

<u>Tetanus</u>, <u>diphtheria</u>, <u>pertussis</u> (<u>Tdap</u>/<u>Td</u>) – Substitute Tdap for Td once, then Td booster every 10 years

Varicella (Chickenpox) – 2 doses

Human papillomavirus – 3 doses

Zoster (Shingles) – 1 dose

<u>Measles</u>, <u>mumps</u>, <u>rubella</u> – 1 or 2 doses depending on indication

Pneumococcal 13 (PCV 13) – 1 dose

<u>Pneumococcal</u> <u>23</u> (<u>PPSV23</u>) - 1 or 2 doses depending on indication

<u>Hepatitis</u> $\mathbf{A} - 1$ or 2 doses depending on vaccine

Hepatitis B - 3 doses

Meningococcal - 1 or more doses depending on indication

Meningococcal B – 2 or 3 doses depending on vaccine

<u>Haemophilus</u> influenza type b (<u>Hib</u>) – 1 or 3 doses depending on indication

You may have already been immunized when you were younger with some of the immunizations above. Always discuss with your primary care physicians which vaccinations are right for your age and medical condition.

HTOTW: Immunizations are not just for children. We still need to be immunized to protect ourselves and all the loved ones around us who have not been or unable to be immunized.
