You may have noticed the new addition of St. Mary's corner stone dated 1906. It was found at 310 E. Williams while doing some work to the breezeway. The property was originally owned by John Vilkanskas and the house was built by his son John and wife Eleanor in 1954. It is presently owned by Stephani Blackney. The original church began to sink due to the coal mine. Fr. Siesel decided to build a new church and rectory which would be solid and construction began on the present church on April 1, 1948. The Day of Dedication was celebrated with Bishop Schlarman on April 30, 1950. The original corner stone returned home to St. Mary's after some 62 years and is placed by the corner stone for our present day church.
