## **NURSE'S CORNER**

**STROKE:** It is the 3rd leading cause of death and the leading cause of disability in the United States. Recent advances in stroke research have shown that we can not only help people to return home, but in many cases either reverse or minimize the extent of their disability. Seek treatment immediately after the onset of symptoms.

#### Think FAST:

- **FACE:** Sudden weakness or numbness in the face, sudden severe headache
- ARMS: Sudden weakness or numbness in one arm or leg
- **SPEECH:** Sudden trouble speaking, seeing, or understanding
- TIME: To ACT FAST; call 911 and ask them to take you to the nearest Primary Stroke Center. Remember TIME is of the utmost importance.

**Some trivia from our recent wellness and exercise class:** Did you know that the FREE FOODS served at restaurants are usually a detriment to our diet. For example:

- Bottomless salad with dressing & breadstick (1) 500 calories; breadstick by itself 150 calories
- Unlimited Pancakes—2 with maple flavored syrup—473 calories
- Chips and Salsa—430 calories
- Endless fries—396 calories
- Cheddar biscuits (1) 150 calories
