NURSE'S CORNER

So far it has been a mild winter with no snow. However, this morning there was a bit of blustery cold snowy weather that reminds us to take precautions and not to overexert if shoveling snow is necessary. Be aware of heart attack symptoms and seek emergency care if they occur (call 911).

Heart Attack Symptoms:

- **Chest pain or discomfort**
- **Upper body pain**
- **Stomach pain**
- **Shortness of breath**
- **Anxiety**
- **Lightheadedness**
- **Sweating**
- **Nausea and vomiting**
- **Neck, jaw, shoulder, upper back discomfort**
- **Heartburn**
- **Unusual or unexplained fatigue**

Heart attack symptoms vary widely. You may have only mild chest pain while someone else has excruciating pain. One thing applies to everyone. If you suspect you are having a heart attack, call 911 immediately. Don't waste time trying to diagnose heart attack symptoms yourself. Most heart attacks begin with subtle symptoms. Getting help quickly greatly improves your chances of survival and minimizes damage to your heart. Remember stay healthy, exercise, eat the right foods, keep weight normal, stop smoking and get routine check-ups.
