## Women's Care Clinic Walk for Life Results

This years walk blessed the Care Clinic with \$86,994.74 in pledges surpassing their goal of \$80,000. St. Mary's Church placed in the top 10 churches with 10 walkers raising \$2,981. Our own Lloyd Wiesemann placed in the top 10 walkers raising \$1,095. Way to go Lloyd! New Life Christian Center placed first with 61 walkers. These funds will allow the Care Clinic to plan for growth, such as increasing availability of ultrasound through training of additional nurses, the development of a men's ministry component and whatever else God calls them to do.
