Seasonal Influenza (Flu) Reminder:

Take time to get a flu vaccine "shot". If you have not done so yet, seriously consider getting one. Many pharmacies offer flu shots in addition to your doctor. This is the first and most important step in protecting against flu viruses. According to CDC, everyone 6 months of age and older should get a flu vaccine. Vaccination of high risk persons is especially important to decrease their risk of severe flu illness. Children younger than 6 months are at high risk in serious flu illness, but are too young to be vaccinated. People who care for them should be vaccinated instead. Get your flu shot SOON!
