Diabetes Testing & Managing Your Diabetes: According to the CDC there are several ways to diagnose diabetes. Each way usually needs to be repeated on a second day to diagnose diabetes.

Testing should be carried out in a health care setting (such as your doctor's office or a lab). If your doctor determines that your blood glucose level is very high, or if you have classic symptoms of high blood glucose in addition to one positive test, your doctor may not require a second test to diagnose diabetes.

- The A1C test measures your average blood glucose for the past 2 to 3 months
- Fasting Plasma Glucose (FPG) checks your fasting blood glucose levels
- Oral Glucose Tolerance Test (also called the OGTT) is a 2 hour test that checks your blood glucose levels before and 2 hours after you drink a special sweet drink

Managing diabetes from the beginning can mean fewer health problems later on. It's a balancing act—food, activity, medicine, and blood sugar levels—but one you can master. Manage your diabetes throughout the day by:

- Following a healthy eating plan, including eating more fruits and vegetables and less sugar and salt
- Getting physically active—10 to 20 minutes a day is better than only an hour once a week
- Taking diabetic medicine as prescribed by your doctor
- Testing your blood sugar regularly to understand and track how food, activity and medicine affect your blood sugar levels
